Entry to Venues (Includes fields and facilities)	a) fully vaccinated people aged 16 years and over; b) children under the age of 16, and; c) people who have been issued with a medical contraindication certificate compliant with the Order. Proof of vaccination must be shown and Checked in using Service NSW QR Code	Open to all persons and checked in using Service NSW QR Code
Covid Safety Plan	Must have 'community sport' COVID-19 Safety Plan	Must have 'community sport' COVID-19 Safety Plan
Service NSW QR Code	Affiliates must register as a COVID Safe business and use QR Codes	Affiliates must register as a COVID Safe business and use QR Codes
Vaccination Take reasonable steps to ensure all people aged 16 and over on the premises are fully vaccinated or have a medical exemption (including staff, volunteers & attendees)	Ensure posters outlining vaccination requirements are clearly visible; remind players, officials, volunteers and spectators of vaccination requirements in marketing and communications materials; check vaccination status upon arrival and only accept valid forms of evidence of vaccination; train staff and volunteers on ways to check proof of COVID-19 vaccination status. For registered participants this status only needs to be checked once and record that it has been checked.	Open to all persons and checked in using Service NSW QR Code
Masks	Mandatory indoors (except when eating or drinking). Not required outdoors. Mandatory for front of house hospitality staff/volunteers even if outdoors. (i.e. Canteen/BBQ/bar)	Mandatory indoors while travelling on public transport, on planes, at airports, and for front-of-house hospitality workers. Not required in any other indoor settings or when outdoors (including for front-of-house hospitality workers).
COVID-19 safe outdoor gatherings for community sporting activities (Includes players, referees, spectators & officials)	Community sporting activity to be the lesser of 1,000 persons or 1 person per 2 square metres.	No limit on the number of people who can attend informal outdoor gatherings. Community Sport COVID Safe plan required for outdoor events with more than 1,000 people.
Ensure 1.5m physical distancing	- At points of mixing or queuing - Between seated groups - Between staff / volunteers.	No restriction

Minimise mingling of participants from different games and timeslots where possible	Particularly people aged under 16 who may not yet be fully vaccinated. Consider staggering the starting times for different groups to minimise crowding where possible	No restriction
Avoid congestion of people in specific areas	Reduce crowding and promote physical distancing in communal facilities such as showers, change rooms and lockers	No restriction
Display conditions of entry including requirements to stay away if unwell, COVID-19 vaccination and record keeping.	Yes	Yes
Have strategies to manage gatherings that may occur immediately outside the premises	Such as pick-up/drop-off zones and staggered start/finish times	No restriction
Representative Training	Any other outdoor gathering is permitted to have up to 1000 people A COVID-19 Safety Plan is not required if the gathering is no more than 50 people.	No restriction
Social Events	Any other outdoor gathering is permitted to have up to 50 people A COVID-19 Safety Plan is not required for this type of gathering	No restriction
Travel – Greater Sydney, Wollongong, Shellharbour, Blue Mountains & Central Coast	Restricted travel within Greater Sydney, Wollongong, Shellharbour, Blue Mountains & Central Coast. Where possible, encourage participants to avoid carpools with people from different household groups	Unrestricted travel within NSW
Travel – Regional NSW	Restricted travel within NSW Regions. Where possible, encourage participants to avoid carpools with people from different household groups	Unrestricted travel within NSW
